SAFE AND FUN PROGRAMS

Boys & Girls Clubs of Tucson is committed to ensuring young people who need us most have a safe place to access during this challenging time for our community. We have launched a special day camp for critical service employees at our Frank & Edith Morton Clubhouse (3155 East Grant Road). Registration will be on a first-come, first-serve basis for working families – *prioritizing service for Health Care Workers, First Responders and those who provide other vital services to our community*.

Due to high need for childcare locally, we are asking individuals who are able to work from home or who do not need to work during this time to leave the limited spots we have available for those who must work.

Day Camp will offer educational learning experiences, such as STEM, art, computer lab and other project based activities. It is our intention to keep children engaged and having fun during this time of uncertainty.

PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING:

- · BGCT staff will be paired with groups of 9 or less youth.
- · Groups will move independently within the facility separated from other groups.
- · Groups will sanitize and disinfect their areas between transitions.
- · Groups will wash their hands regularly and follow a hand washing schedule.
- · Breakfast, Lunch and Snacks will be provided.
